For World Hearing on the 3rd March, a campaign was carried out to check and clean ears, and perform audiological tests, in order to raise awareness of hearing care and prevent deafness. We had a large influx of people, mainly children and young people.



Our health team travelled to the the town of San Borja, 233 km away from our city, to perform ear otoscopy and audiological tests with the residents of that town. They were very grateful to our staff and the institution for having gone there, as there were many people with earache problems.
