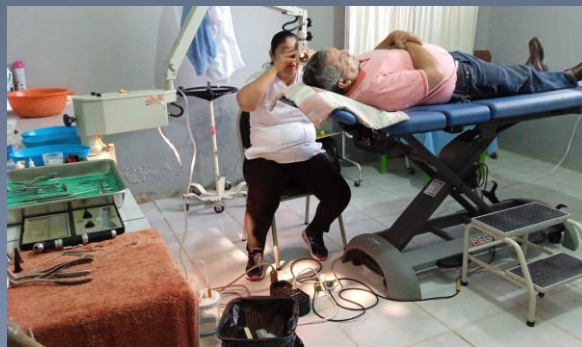




# FUNDACIÓN TOTAÍ UPDATE

**JULY – SEPTEMBER 2022**

From the 8<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> August, our health team travelled 387 km to the town of Rurrenabaque, to continue with our work of reaching out into the community to support those in need. We provided medical consultations in the areas of ENT and audiological examinations, with essential medication being distributed also. We had never been to that town before because it is so far away, and the local community there were especially grateful to the foundation for the care provided.



On 10<sup>th</sup> August we were invited to return to San Borja, 233 km away, to carry out hearing checks and audiological tests. We were able to help 30 people with hearing impairments, and this means that they can now register with the Ministry of Health and they can receive their disability support benefits. It's a real privilege to build relationships with local communities and to be invited to return to provide continued healthcare for the local people, and to provide essential support to allow people to access vital disability benefits.

With great joy, we organized the 5-day holiday club called "The Gospel of Power" for the children in the local neighbourhoods near Fundación Totafí. We had an average of 70 children participating and we spent 5 amazing days, playing games, doing crafts and having lots of fun, but the most important part was the time spent learning God's word. We want to thank all of the volunteers who helped us make this activity possible, especially Rachel Peebles and Niamh McIvor, who were visiting from Scotland and supported us to run the club.

Some of the local mums are being supported through the arts and crafts programme at Fundación Totafí. They recently received recognition from the Municipal Government of Trinidad as "women entrepreneurs" in the city, and they participated in a local fair, showcasing the products they make in the weekly classes. Some of the items included recycled glass bottles and other items.
