TOTAÍ ACADEMY Learning Together

In 2024, we launched a new initiative within our Aprendamos Juntos (Learning Together) classes. We introduced academic support sessions focused on literacy and mathematics for children in the first through third grades.

Since the program began, we have seen encouraging progress in each child's development. We are also grateful for the invaluable support of our volunteer, Caity, who joined us from the UK and dedicated several months to assisting the children.

Throughout the year, we worked with several children facing different educational challenges. Some struggled with basic literacy and numeracy, while others had fallen behind in school or lacked family support. Despite these difficulties, many of the children showed notable improvements in their reading, writing, and mathematical skills.



Some even progressed from being unable to recognize letters to reading simple texts and solving basic arithmetic problems. These successes would not have been possible without the commitment of our team and the patience and dedication of volunteers like Caity and Simon, who went above and beyond to ensure the children had the support they needed.

- For the children attending this year, that their parents would become more engaged in their education.
- For continued progress in the children's literacy and numeracy skills, that they would not lose what they have learned.
- For more volunteers to join our work, especially those with a passion for education and working with children.

TOTAÍ Futsal School

Throughout 2024, the rainy season brought both challenges and new opportunities for our futsal programme.

For over five years, we had been borrowing a pitch in a neighbouring area, but this past year we were blessed to build our own grass pitch in our community. We trained on it for much of the year, but when the rainy season arrived, persistent flooding forced us to pause. Faced with a choice—either return to the old pitch or find a solution closer to home —we chose to stay rooted in our neighbourhood.

That's when we discovered an abandoned concrete pitch nearby. Over several days, we cleared weeds, collected rubbish, and painted fresh lines, transforming it into a vibrant new home for our futsal programme. By the time the school holidays arrived, the pitch was ready, and the children couldn't have been more excited.



Looking ahead, we're working on long-term solutions to the flooding issue, including adding specialised grass designed for football pitches or even artificial turf. We're also hoping to install lights, allowing us to train in the evenings and make the pitch a true hub for the community. These improvements will ensure that rain or shine, our programme can continue to thrive.

This year, three of our teams competed in the city's futsal tournament, each showing incredible teamwork and determination:

Under-9s and Under-12s teams – Both teams finished fifth, narrowly missing the playoffs but demonstrating great sportsmanship and growth.

Under-10s – Secured third place after a thrilling penalty shootout, a moment that had everyone on the edge of their seats!

But our futsal programme is about more than just matches and trophies. It's about building relationships, making disciples, and creating opportunities to support families in practical ways. For example, as the new academic year began, we provided six children with new uniforms, shoes, and school supplies, ensuring they started the year with confidence and dignity.

We're excited to continue training, competing, and sharing the Gospel with all involved. These relationships are at the heart of what we do, and we're grateful for your support in making this possible.

MUSIC Programme

Last year, we shared that, through the consolidation of ministries with Red Roots, we inherited a thriving music programme. This initiative was

originally created as a way to connect with young people in our neighbourhood, offering them access to music lessons—something many could never have afforded otherwise. It also served as a bridge to discipleship and, for some, an escape from difficult home environments.

Over the past year, the programme has exceeded our expectations. Many of the students have grown in both their musical abilities and their faith. In fact, the vast majority of our church's worship team today is made up of young people who first learned to play their instruments through this very programme! Beyond music, many of the students are actively involved in the life of the church and are being discipled as they grow in their relationship with Christ.



Looking ahead, we are praying that this programme will continue to flourish—not simply by producing skilled musicians, but by raising up disciples of Jesus who live for His glory in every aspect of their lives.

TOTAÍ Clinic

This year marked a significant milestone for our clinic—20 years of God's faithfulness!

Over the past two decades, the clinic has served thousands upon thousands of patients, provided countless affordable surgeries, and touched the lives of families across our community.

What began as a vision to share the gospel and provide excellent, low-cost healthcare to those in need is now bearing fruit, as we witness countless lives touched by both physical healing and the hope of Christ.

We are continually amazed by how God brings volunteers and medical professionals from all over the world to join us in this work. Their skills and hearts for service have allowed us to expand our services and extend Christ's love to those who enter our doors.



These additions have allowed us to care for patients in even more comprehensive ways, all while maintaining our goal of providing high-quality care at a low cost—and sometimes at no cost at all.

Throughout the year, we saw God's hand at work in the lives of our patients. From a neighbour who suffered a severe laceration while training horses, to a woman who finally received the eyeglasses she had needed for years but could never afford, to a young man who underwent a long-awaited ear surgery to treat a chronic infection—each story is a testimony of God's provision.

But our clinic is about more than just treating ailments; it's a place where relationships are built, trust is earned, and the love of Christ is made visible. Every consultation, every surgery, every conversation is an opportunity to share the hope we have in Jesus.

As we celebrate this 20-year milestone, we look forward with great anticipation to what God will do in the years to come. We truly believe that the best is yet to come.


