2025: A YEAR OF STRENGTHENING Foundations

Trinidad, Bolivia

As we look back on 2025, one word stands out: foundation.

This was not a year defined by rapid expansion. Instead, it was a year of deepening — strengthening relationships, refining vision, and investing patiently in people and communities. Across healthcare, youth development, discipleship, and outreach, we have seen God work through faithfulness, generosity, and steady presence.

FAITHFUL CARE, Real Impact

Throughout 2025, Totali Clinic continued to provide accessible, high-quality healthcare to families who would otherwise struggle to receive care due to economic pressure, fuel shortages, and rising costs.

Over the course of the year, the clinic recorded **11,163 patient visits** across a wide range of services — including general medicine, dentistry, ear and hearing care, speech therapy, paediatrics, cardiology, physiotherapy, psychology, laboratory services, and diagnostic imaging.

These numbers represent far more than statistics. Each visit reflects a person seen, listened to, and treated with dignity. For many families, the clinic has become a trusted place — not only for medical care, but for ongoing relationships and support.

This trust has also enabled the clinic to serve as a foundation for outreach beyond the city itself.

GROWING ROOTS BEYOND TRINIDAD Ministry in Loreto

and Surrounding Villages

In 2025, we began taking intentional, repeated steps into the village of Loreto (about an hour away) and nearby communities.

Loreto is a village that, for understandable reasons, has become cautious and even resistant toward evangelical churches and ministries due to past experiences. Rather than pushing against that resistance, we have sought to come with humility, patience, and service.

Our medical clinic has provided a natural and welcomed entry point. By offering compassionate healthcare in places where it is often unavailable, doors have opened for conversation, trust, and deeper relationships. These visits are not one-off events, but part of a growing commitment to consistent presence.

During these village visits, teams were able to provide dental care, general medical consultations, physical therapy, and audiology services — care that is rarely accessible in these communities.



We were also honoured this year to host a team from Huntington, West Virginia (USA), who partnered with us as we visited several villages. Together, we were able to provide much-needed medical attention in places where healthcare simply does not exist.



These shared experiences strengthened relationships both locally and across borders, and reinforced our hope that faithful service, over time, will prepare the ground for a lasting, gospel-centred presence.

A YEAR OF JOY AND PROVISION

Our Futsal Programme



Our futsal programme was exceptionally blessed in 2025 through the generosity of partners and supporters.

The children received brand-new uniforms, new futsal shoes, training vests, and a range of practical equipment — including clipboards, coaching whistles, and water bottles. For many of the kids, this was the first time they had ever worn a complete uniform or played in proper futsal shoes.

The shoes were donated by Mission Grounds Coffee, while the uniforms were made possible through Women of Spirit and Graphic Solutions.

These gifts did more than improve training sessions — they communicated something deeper: you matter. Seeing the kids step onto the court with confidence, pride, and joy was one of the clearest reminders of how sport can be a powerful tool for discipleship, belonging, and hope.



Introducing Capa•cita

EQUIPPING THE NEXT GENERATION OF WOMEN



One of the most meaningful — though often less visible — ministries in 2025 was Capa•cita, a programme we launched this year for at-risk teenage girls.

The name Capa•cita reflects the heart of the programme. Capacita means to train, equip, or empower. In everyday language, “capa” is a way of describing someone who is capable, strong, and able. “Cita” refers to a purposeful meeting or moment — an intentional space for connection.

Together, the name captures what Capa•cita is about: intentionally equipping young women through relational moments that help them grow into capable, confident people, rooted in faith and character.

The programme is built on a simple conviction:
“Exposure precedes expectation”.

Many of the girls we walk alongside have never seen women from similar backgrounds working in professional roles, serving their communities, or living with confidence and purpose. Through intentional exposure to women in different vocations — alongside mentoring, relationship, and exposure to the gospel — the girls begin to see new possibilities for their own lives.

At its core, however, Capa•cita is a discipleship ministry. We believe the gospel brings real transformation, shaping identity, character, relationships, and hope for the future. By walking patiently with these young women, we are investing in long-term change that reaches far beyond any single programme or outcome.



LOOKING AHEAD with Gratitude

2025 was a year marked by faithfulness rather than flash, by relationships rather than results, and by patient obedience rather than quick wins.

We are deeply grateful to every supporter, partner, volunteer, and praying friend who made this work possible. Your generosity and faith have allowed us to keep showing up — in clinics, on courts, in classrooms, and in villages — trusting God to bring growth in His time.

As we look toward 2026, we do so with expectation, rooted in the foundations laid this past year.
